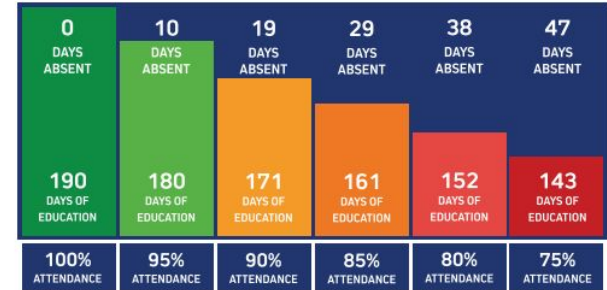
#Attendance Matters

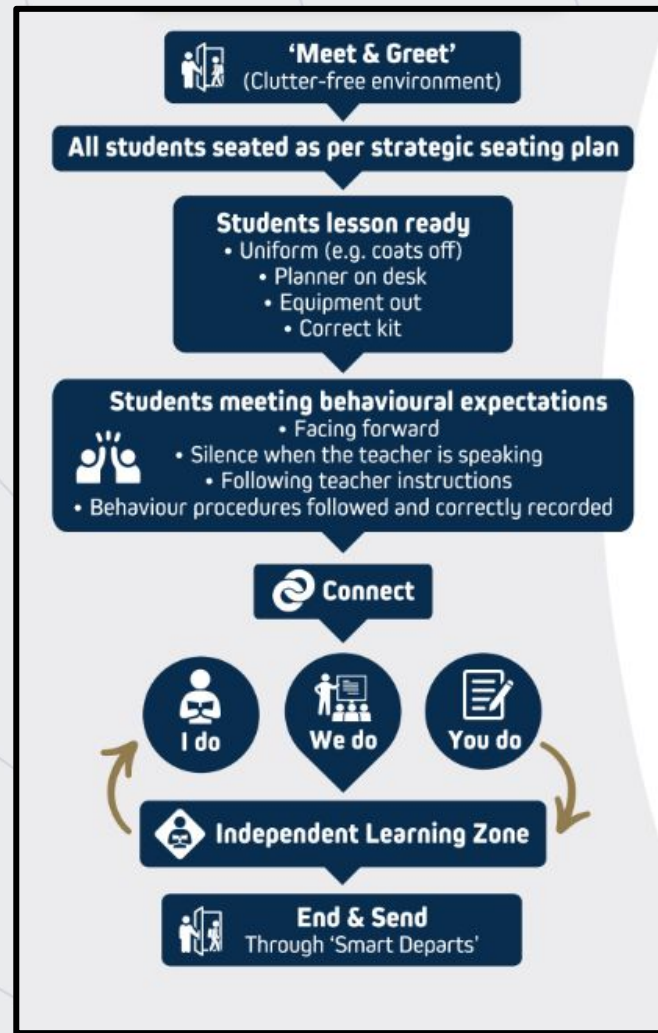
